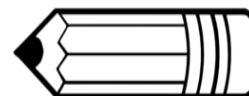

- color schemes

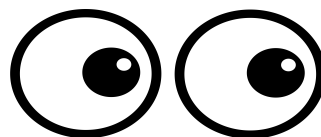
## Materials needed DAILY:
